We need to plant more gospel ministries. We need to do that in all sorts of ways, within and without the various denominational structures, using true and tried methods and new and risky ideas no-one has heard of yet.

To help a greater alliance of ministry multipliers, this is a call to you to the PLAN TO PLANT day of learning, thinking and sharing ideas. This is a coal-face conference gathering people who are currently planting, planning to plant or dreaming of it. We want to have denominational, non-denominational, independent and other people who are keen about multiplying ministries- and plan to plant.

We all need the constant encouragement of others. This day is accessible, affordable, practical and encouraging . Plan to come along ready to share and receive ideas, and be energised in your ministry planting."

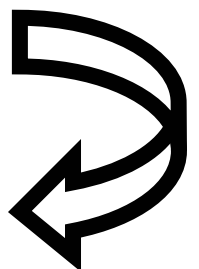

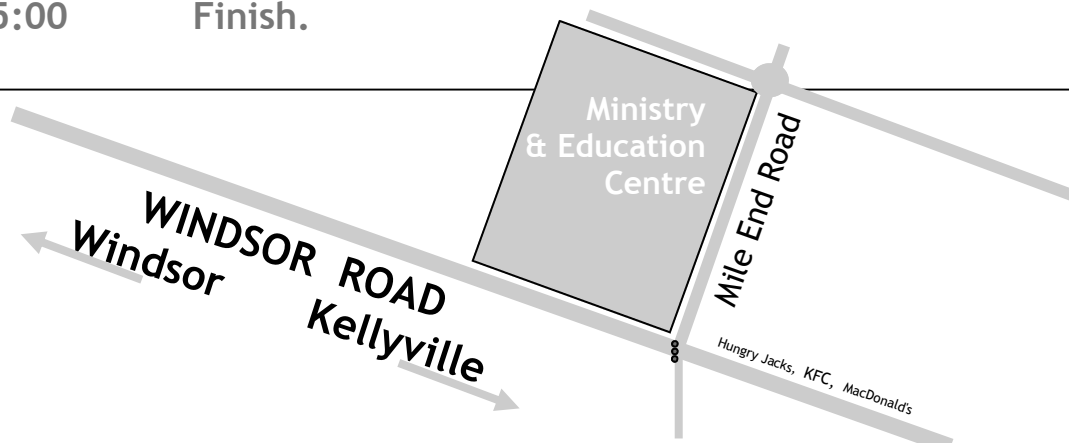
