Day 1

Bible verse and prayer for today

Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth. ² Sing to the Lord, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day. ³ Declare his glory among the nations, his marvellous deeds among all peoples.

Psalm 96:1-3

Come to the Lord today, praising his name and rejoicing in his salvation. But also note the exhortation of this Psalm – that we not only praise God for our salvation – but that we also share the glorious news of the God who saves, with all people!

Bathurst Diocese: We begin by praying for the parishes in the **Eastern Archdeaconry**: Bathurst, Kelso, Cudgegong Valley, Blayney, Oberon, and Coolah-Dunedoo. Thank the Lord for the new Archdeacon, the Venerable Tim St Quintin, who is supporting the clergy and parishes in this area.

Pray for All Saints Cathedral Parish with the Dean, the Very Rev'd James Hodson and his wife Fran, along with senior associate minister, the Rev'd Phil Howes and his wife Sho. Pray also for the Rev'd James Boardman (with his wife Charly and their children) as assistant minister; a training role, supported by BCA. Pray that the ministry in Bathurst will grow more effective in *SHARING JESUS FOR LIFE*.

National Church: The Primate of Australia, Archbishop Geoffrey Smith and the Secretary of General Synod Anne Hywood. Pray that they will have grace and wisdom for their responsibilities across the Anglican Church of Australia. Pray for those on the standing committee of General synod – that they will have godly wisdom for their meetings.

Day 2

Bible verse and prayer for today

For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6

Thank the Lord today for Jesus. And thank the Lord that one day we will see the promise of Isaiah 9 in complete fulfilment when Jesus returns, and his reign is revealed in all its glory.

Loving God, thank you for your Son, who came among us in humility but who will one day reign in glory for all eternity.

Keep us in this hope and hasten the day of Jesus' return, for we ask it in Jesus' name. Amen.

Bathurst Diocese: We pray today for the parish of Kelso – especially praying that the Lord will raise up a faithful minister for this parish. We pray that eventually with a new minister, the many people in the new housing areas of Kelso may be reached with the news of Jesus.

National Church: The Diocese of Adelaide with Archbishop Geoffrey Smith, Assistant Bishops Timothy Harris and Denise Ferguson; Assistant Bishop for Aboriginal Ministry Chris McLeod; clergy and people. Pray that they will be faithful shepherds, and that God will bless their work.

Day 3

Bathurst Diocese: We pray for Coolah-Dunedoo parish. We thank the Lord for the Rev'd Ross Craven who serves the parish currently one day a week. Give thanks too for LLM Dr James White who serves one weekend a month. But we also need to pray that the Lord will raise up a new permanent full-time minister and provide the necessary funds.

National Church: The Diocese of Armidale with Bishop Rod Chiswell, clergy and people. Pray that the gospel will be proclaimed with power throughout Armidale diocese. Thank the Lord for the partnership evolving between our dioceses whereby ministers may be trained in Armidale as assistant ministers, before serving in our Diocese.

Other needs: Pray for Cursillo, AWA and Mothers' Union within our Diocese, asking that these groups will help people grow in their discipleship and be unified in the gospel our Lord Jesus Christ; excited to SHARE JESUS FOR LIFE.

Day 4

Bathurst Diocese: The Parish of Blayney, and the Rev'd Wally Cox and Jordan, the Rev'd Bec Choi and Yooie. Praise God for the financial support for Bec which has come from individuals and parishes in Sydney. Pray that together with lay leaders, the work in Blayney will flourish and reach those who do not yet know Jesus.

National Church: The Diocese of Ballarat with Bishop Garry Weatherill, clergy and people. Pray that they will be sustained and strengthened in their work for the glory of God.

Other needs: Pray for the police in our region: in the stations, as they deal with difficult situations, those on highway patrol. Pray for their safety and protection. Also pray for Police Chaplains – among them are Bishop Richard Hurford, the Rev'd Carl Palmer, and the Rev'd Gary Neville.

Day 5

Bible verse and prayer for today

For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight.

Bathurst Diocese: The Parish of Oberon: Praise God for the Rev'd Jonny Lush as minister in Oberon and ask God's wisdom and strength for Jonny and Liz in their second year of ministry there. Thank the Lord for those individuals and parishes who have generously helped support Jonny's ministry.

National Church: We join with the Church throughout Australia who today pray for the Diocese of Bathurst, for Bishop Mark Calder and Susan, the clergy and people. Pray that they will be faithful and fruitful and have the joy of seeing the Lord at work through them. Pray for rest and refreshment in long service leave between Christmas and Easter in the early part of this year.

National Church: The Diocese of Bendigo with Bishop Matt Brain, clergy and people. Pray that churches would grow and flourish and that the bishop may be given wisdom and strength.

Day 7

National Church: The Diocese of Brisbane with new Archbishop Jeremy Greaves. Pray for the assistant bishops: Cam Venables and John Roundhill – with one additional appointment to be made this year. Pray too for all the clergy and people. May the leadership be true to God's word and faithful in building up all the churches in the diocese.

Other needs: Pray for communities whose population is declining and who are losing their identity. Pray for the smaller villages in the parishes within our Diocese. May people see the hope that Christians have through Jesus and long to know the reason why. May we have a ready answer.

Day 8

Day 10

Other needs: Pray for those discerning the call of God on their lives to lay and ordained ministry, and those preparing for ordination. Pray for those have taken up aspects of the former Ministry Development Officer role: Andrew Thornhill, Jono Williams, Kath Thornhill, James Daymond and Phil Howes. Pray they will be given wisdom for these additional responsibilities.

Day 11

Bible verse and prayer for today

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— ⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast. ¹⁰ For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Ephesians 2:8-10

As your saved, forgiven and reconciled people, please help us by your Spirit
to do the good works you've prepared in advance for us to do.

Pray that many will be helped to grow in their understanding of and love for the Lord Jesus.

National Church: The Diocese of Gippsland with Bishop Richard Treloar, clergy and people. Pray that clergy and people will be passionate about proclaiming the good news in word and deed.

Other needs: Pray for the implementation of the Diocesan strategic plan, centred around the catch phrase *SHARING JESUS FOR LIFE*. Please pray that each parish might consider how they can take elements of the plan and put adapt and adopt them for their own parish and context. Pray that the plan will strengthen the witness of our diocese to the great news of Jesus and help train and equip us all in the task of making Jesus known.

Day 12

Day 13

Bible verse and prayer for today

And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, ¹⁸ may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹ and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

Pray that the Lord would sustain those carrying the load of ministry in these places at the present time and pray that the Lord would bring forward for ministry, those men and women who would be just right for these towns. Pray for Bishop Mark and members of the recruitment task force, that they would have wisdom and creativity as they encourage people to consider ministry in the diocese.

Day 14

Bible verse and prayer for today

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, ²¹ to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen. Ephesians 3:20-21

National Church: The Diocese of Melbourne with Archbishop Phillip Freier and assistant bishops Genieve Blackwell, Kate Prowd, Brad Billings and Paul Barker. Pray for unity in the diocese centred on the good news of Jesus and a desire to make Christ known.

Other needs: Please pray for the financial sustainability task force, that you would give them wisdom as they seek to lead our diocese to a better financial position. Thank the Lord for the generous gift of the Sydney Diocese of \$250,000 a year which has now been renewed through to 2030. But pray that ministry might so grow and flourish in our parishes, that we might be in a better situation by 2030 to be self-sustaining.

Day 16

Bible verse and prayer for today

chaplains and visitors. Pray that your parish will grow in love and unity in prayerfulness and in joyful dependence on God. Pray that the good news of Jesus will be made known through the ministry of everyone in your parish, as we work together to SHARE JESUS FOR LIFE.

Day 17

Bible verse and prayer for today

So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, ¹² to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up... Ephesians 4:11-12

God of glory, thank you for continuing to gift the church with evangelists, pastors and teachers.

Thank you that as they equip your people for ministry, your body, the church is built up.

Please help all evangelists, pastors and teachers to prioritise equipping your people

Day 18

Bible verse and prayer for today

...to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up ¹³ until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

Ephesians 4:12-13

Thank you, heavenly Father, that your body the church grows as we are equipped for the service of others. Day 20

Bible verse and prayer for today

Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbour, for we are all members of one body. ²⁶ "In your anger do not sin". Ephesians 4:25-26a

Loving God, may truth mark all our relationships,
especially in the body of Christ.
And when there is appropriate reason for us to be angry,
please help us to deal with that in a godly and gentle way,
through Jesus Christ our Lord and Saviour. Amen

Bathurst Diocese: The parish of Narromine. Pray that the Lord will raise up a new minister for the work there and sustain those who carry the load in the meantime. May Bible studies started last year continue to strengthen people's understanding of God's word and their love for Jesus.

National Church: The Diocese of Riverina with Bishop Donald Kirk, clergy and people. Pray for wisdom for the leadership of the diocese that they will serve their people well and build up the churches across the diocese to the glory of God.

Other needs: Pray for world leaders and decision-makers; those who hold power and influence through politics, finance, the media or industry. May we work together for the common good.

Day 21

Bible verse and prayer for today

Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. Ephesians 4:29

Please dear Lord, help us to be careful before we speak.

Help us realise in advance if something on our heart to say, will not actually be helpful in any way. Help us to have wisdom to discern and discipline to say, only what will be helpful for building others up, so that it will benefit all who listen. We ask this in Jesus' name. Amen.

Bathurst Diocese: Parish of Gilgandra. Pray that the Lord will raise up someone new to lead this parish, and that there will be open doors and hearts for the good news of Jesus. Thank the Lord for honorary Deacon, the Rev'd Anne Younghusband and Neville along with the very active lay ministers. Ask the Lord to provide financially for the substantial repair works which are needed on the church building and thank the Lord for the hospitality of the Uniting Church who have welcomed the Anglican congregation while they cannot meet in their building. Pray for ordination candidate, Stuart Border.

National: The Diocese of Rockhampton and Bishop Peter Grice, and for the clergy and people. Pray for wisdom for Peter as he leads – especially that he will know how best to allocate his time and build up his team of clergy. Pray for many new workers for parishes without clergy and the funds to support them.

Please Father, help us to be more and more like you: kind and compassionate, forgiving one another, just as through Jesus, you have forgiven us.

May all relationships be shaped by this kindness, compassion, forgiveness.

We pray this in Jesus' name. Amen.

Bathurst Diocese: The parish of Trundle - another parish without an ordained minister. Please pray for the licenced lay ministers who are carrying on with love and devotion — but also pray that the Lord will raise someone to minister across the parish and in the many centres, to the glory of God and the building up of his church. Pray also that the Lord will provide the funds needed to support a minister full time.

National Church: The Diocese of Sydney with Archbishop Kanishka Raffel and regional bishops: Michael Stead, Gary Koo, Peter Lin, Peter Hayward, Chris Edwards, and Malcolm Richards along with Archdeacon for women, Kara Hartley, the Dean, Sandy Grant, clergy and people. Thank the Lord for the generosity of the Sydney Diocese, through whose gift, we are able to support our bishop and registrar.

Day 23

Bible verse and prayer for today

Follow God's example, therefore, as dearly loved children ² and walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. Ephesians 5:1-2

Again we pray dear Lord, that you might make us more and more like yourself.

May we walk in the way of love, following the sacrificial example of the Lord Jesus;

giving ourselves in the service of others and of you, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen

Bathurst Diocese: Pray for the parish of Warren. Thank the Lord for the Rev'd Gloria Shipp who has been helping here once a month but is unable to continue. Pray for a wise ministry solution which will provide a loving ministry centred around God's word and the proclamation of the gospel. Pray that the congregation will not lose heart, but trust God for their future.

National Church: The Diocese of Tasmania with Bishop Richard Condie, assistant bishop Chris Jones, and all the clergy and people. Ask the Lord that the diocese will be marked by great joy in the gospel and a passion to proclaim it!

Other needs: Pray for those caught up in addictions to alcohol and drugs, social media, pornography, and other addictions. Pray for those who support them and for the work that people do with twelve step programs. Pray that people would turn to the Lord and that through Jesus, the power and bonds of sin would be broken.

Day 24

Bible verse and prayer for today

Bathurst Diocese: The Parish of Coonabarabran, now without a minister. Pray that the parish will continue to grow from strength to strength as God's word is taught and the great news of the Lord Jesus is shared.

National Church: The Diocese of The Murray. Pray for God's wisdom and guidance regarding leadership in this Diocese and pray that churches may grow and flourish as they proclaim the gospel.

Other needs: Pray for Macquarie Anglican Grammar School; the acting Head, Mrs Alison Mitchell, Chaplain the Rev'd Tom Owen, students, parents and staff - that this school may be effective in pointing students to the life, joy, peace and hope found in relationship with Jesus.

Day 25

Bible verse and prayer for today

Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, ¹⁶ making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. Ephesians 5:15

Loving God, grant us <u>your</u> wisdom we pray that we may always live wisely.

Help us to be wise to the gospel opportunities that regularly come before us, that we might SHARE JESUS FOR LIFE and give a reason for the hope we have.

We ask this, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen

Bathurst Diocese: The Parish of Coonamble. Pray that they will know God's presence and peace as they minister and see the Lord at work through them. Pray that the Lord of the harvest will raise up a minister for them and sustain the licenced lay ministers as they care for God's people in the meantime. National Church: The diocese of the Northern Territory with Bishop Greg Anderson, clergy and people. Praise God for the dean of the cathedral - the Rev'd Rob Llewellyn and pray that the Lord would unite bishop, dean and clergy around the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Other needs: Pray for Orange Anglican Grammar School, the Head, the Rev'd Louis Stringer, students, Chaplaincy Team, staff and parents. Pray that they will be centred around Jesus and help students, parents and staff to understand that Jesus is the way, the truth and the life.

Day 26

Bible verse and prayer for today

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on the full armour of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. Ephesians 6:10-11

Loving God, we often feel week and unable to live your way.

Please help us today and every day to be strong with your strength.

Give us the determination to clothe ourselves with everything you have provided so that we can take a stand against the devil's schemes.

In particular, we ask that we might be people of prayer and your word.

We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

Day 29

Bible verse and prayer for today

Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, ²⁰ for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.

Ephesians 5:19-20

Almighty God, although our bishop and ministers are not in chains, nevertheless, we do pray that whenever they speak, you would give them the right words, so that they will fearlessly make known your good news.

We pray that they will declare your word fearlessly, as they should, all in the name of your Son, Jesus Christ and for his glory. Amen
