The Position

The Principal is expected to be an outstanding leader of good character who will develop and implement strategies to advance the ability of the College to prepare men and women for Christian ministry. The ideal candidate will have an established reputation in theological education coupled with appropriate practical ministry experience. The successful candidate must be in Holy Orders and able to be licensed by the Archbishop of Sydney to minister in the diocese.

About Moore College

Moore College is a leading reformed evangelical theological college in the Anglican tradition offering undergraduate and postgraduate degrees as well as sustaining a significant distance education component.

Men and women are prepared for a lifetime of ministry and mission. Most undergraduate students live in residence. The Principal and faculty also live on campus which is adjacent to the University of Sydney.

There are around 270 fulltime and 90 part time undergraduate students. Additionally more than a hundred students are enrolled in masters and doctoral programs. A highly qualified fulltime faculty of 21 men and women and the largest theological library in Australia enables the delivery of in-depth theological training which is engaging and rigorous.
