#### From our bishop

Dear friends,

Archbishop Geoffrey Smith recently announced his resignation as Primate of the Anglican Church of Australia, and a new Primate is to be elected on 19 July.

The Primate (or Presiding

Bishop) is the elected leader of the national church—but not in the way a CEO or pope might be! The role is more about coordination and representation than command. The Primate chairs meetings of the General Synod (our national church parliament) and the Standing Committee that oversees national matters between synods. He also represents the Anglican Church of Australia in national and international settings.

But it's important to know that the Primate has no legal or spiritual authority over the dioceses. That's because each of our 23 dioceses (including our own) is self-governing. Each has its own bishop, synod, and structures for ministry, mission, and decision-making.

Holding us together is our shared faith in Christ, our common Anglican heritage, and our Constitution. The 1962 Constitution sets out how we relate as dioceses and how we work together nationally. It provides the framework for things like national canons (laws), theological training, liturgy, and standards for ministry.

So, the Primate's role is a crucial one—but it's more about service, unity, and leadership by persuasion than power or control.

Please join me in praying for wisdom and grace as our bishops + elected members of the election board, prepare to elect our next Primate in July.
