From our Bishop

Dear friends,

Synod gathered a month ago with a great sense of joy in being together and a sense that God is at work. In my address to synod, I shared that I only have one agenda: Jesus. I want everyone in our churches to know, love, trust, serve, and share Jesus, and for those outside the church to hear of him, turn to him, and serve him and join us in sharing him.

I shared that in the past five years, I've learned these five lessons:

- 1. God's Amazing Grace: He has provided resources, workers, leadership, and his Spirit in ways beyond imagination.
- 2. Ministry is Hard: Especially in our country towns, where some struggle with fewer people, and some are hardened to the Gospel.
- 3. The Diocese is Vast: Remote congregations feel isolated, and there's potential to better support each other.
- Leaving city life and moving west is a challenge, but we need pioneers willing to make sacrifices.
- 5. People Are Hungry for God's Word: There is a growing desire for clear Bible teaching that transforms lives.

I have three years under our ordinance before I must retire. So I shared with synod, three prayers for three years:

- 1. Supply our needs: workers for the harvest and finances to support them.
- 2. Transform us: renew our hearts, deepen our love for Jesus, and equip us for your service.
- 3. Save the lost: soften hearts, open eyes, and lead many to trust in Jesus. Amen.
